Bomb Threat Checklist

If the threat is received via telephone, keep the caller on the line.

- Listen for background noise, tone of voice, accent, etc. Is the voice familiar? If so, whom does it sound like? Try to approximate the caller's age.
- 2. Obtain and write down the following information:
 - a. When is the bomb set to go off?
 - . Exactly where is the bomb located?
 - What type of bomb is it? How is it constructed?
 - Why is this being done?
- 3. CALL 911
- 4. Do not use any two-way radio system
- 5. After receiving a bomb threat **notify** the below-listed personnel in the following order:
 - a. ERT Lead
 - b. Guest Services Lead
 - c. Senior ACC Staff not currently on the stage
